

Activate Bankfeeds for your Westpac Accounts

If you are a Westpac customer and have Westpac Internet Banking (Westpac Live) you have the ability to provide your accountant advisor with copies of transactions from your nominated Westpac accounts.

To activate your bank feeds:

- Log in to Westpac Live

There are 3 entry points to Connect/Disconnect bank feeds to Third Party Service Providers.

1. Via the **Account Services** menu under Services and Preferences

- a. **Click** Services and Preferences
- b. **Click** Bank feeds

OR

2. Via Account **Account Actions** under Account Activity

OR

3. Via **Exports and reports**
